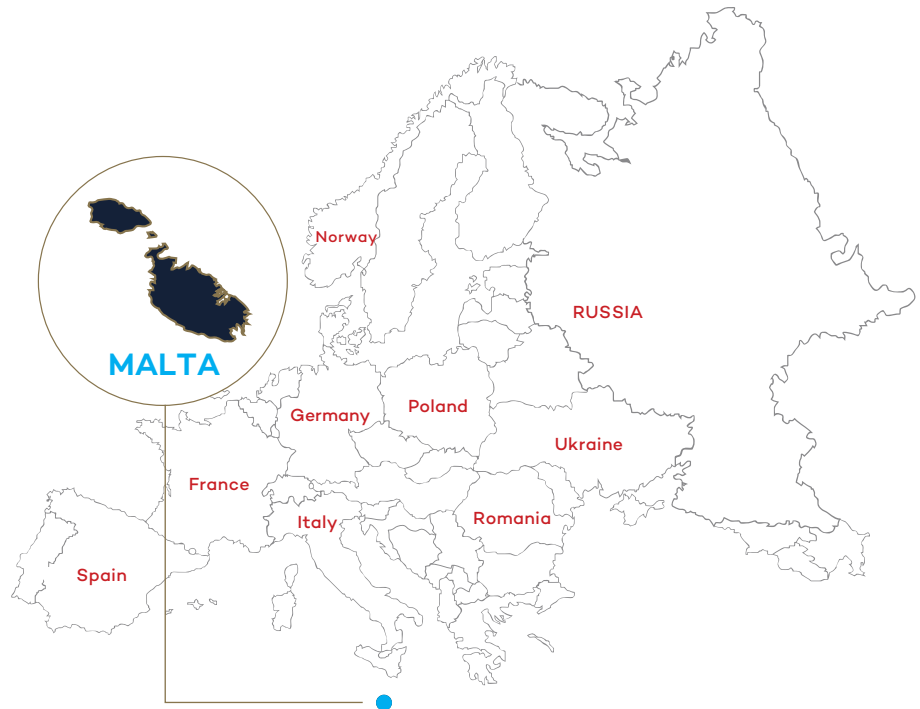

Malta's Individual Investor Program (MIIP)

Malta has been a member of the EU since 2004, and of the Schengen Area since 2007. It enjoys a stable political climate with a low risk of financial instability.

The Maltese Individual Investor Program (MIIP) enables any individual and their family to qualify for Maltese citizenship by contributing to the economic development of Malta. It is the first citizenship program in the EU to have been recognized and officially approved by the European Commission.

Qualifying applicants will be recognized and granted the same rights as any Maltese citizen, including, the freedom to move, work, live, and vote within Malta and also the EU.

English is an official language of Malta (alongside Maltese) and is widely spoken throughout the country. All government forms and documents are produced in English, as well as road signs, restaurant menus, and other important information.

The capital city, Valetta, is a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Malta Citizenship by Investment

Requirements

To qualify for citizenship, the main applicant must be over 18 years of age, be of outstanding character, have no criminal record, be in good health and pass strict government due diligence checks.

► Residence

The main applicant and all adult dependants must have been a legal resident of Malta for three years or by exception at least one year, demonstrating connecting factors to Malta during the residence period, prior to being naturalized.



► Investment

To apply for the Malta Citizenship by Investment Program, applicants must fulfil ALL of the following:

A. Contribution

Option 1

36 MONTHS RESIDENCY

Non-refundable contribution to the National Development and Social Fund.

For Spouse and each Dependant

Option 2

12 MONTHS RESIDENCY

Non-refundable contribution to the National Development and Social Fund for a shorter application turn around.

B. Property

For Malta citizenship by naturalization, applicants must meet one of the following criteria

D. Health Insurance

All applicants of the Malta Citizenship by Investment Program must have Global Health Coverage during the residency period.

E. Charity Donation

For a family application: government due diligence, admin fees and the investment will increase depending on the number of dependants.

Malta Residency by Investment

Requirements

The primary applicant must be at least 18 years of age to qualify for the MPRP. They must declare that they have in possession a minimum of EUR 500,000 in capital assets, of which, EUR 150,000 must be shown as available liquid assets.

An application can include all minor children up to the age of 18, adult children over 18 years if they are financially dependent upon the main applicant and are not married; and parents or grandparents of the main applicant, who can also prove they are economically dependent.

All dependants over the age of 18 years require an affidavit of support for inclusion within the application. The main applicant and any dependants must have a clean personal background with no criminal record and must be in good health with Malta health insurance in place.

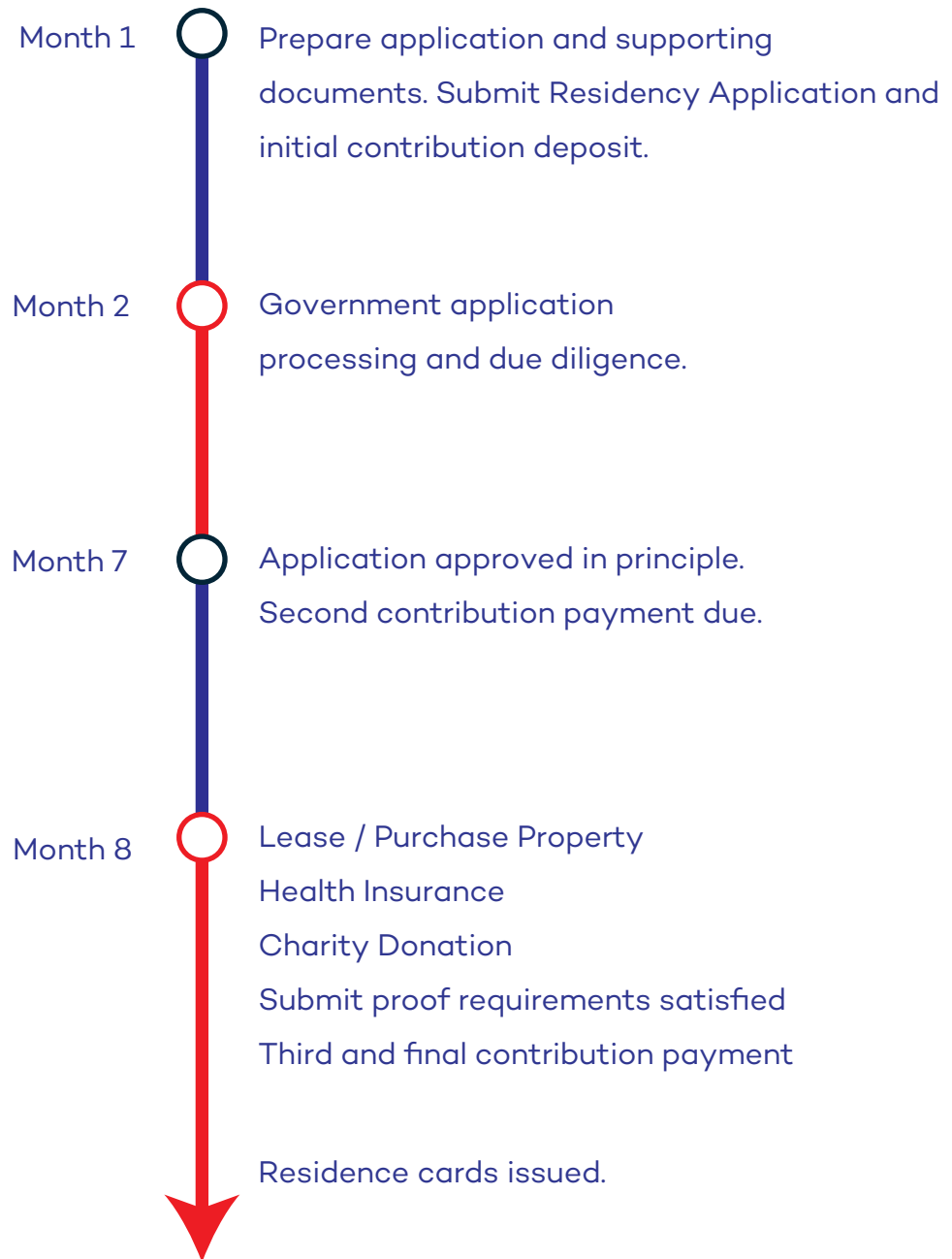

For both options, applicants can add parents or grandparents for an additional contribution fee of EUR 7,500 each.

Whether purchasing or leasing a property, the minimum hold time is five years, either route will also require a mandatory charity donation of EUR 2,000.

Application Process



Visa Free Countries

The citizens of Malta can visit 117 countries without a visa. Maltese passport holders also have access to get 30 e-visas or 18 visas on arrival.

Nearby countries: The nearest visa free countries to visit for Maltese passport holders are Tunisia, Vatican City, Italy, Albania, Montenegro and Greece.
